STRUCTURE:

3 round Swiss System; may be multiple sections.

TIME LIMIT:

Game/60, or game/55 with a 5 second delay.

GUARANTEED PRIZES:

First \$100, Second \$50 based on a minimum of 4 entries.

Prizes increased if more than 8 entries.
