- Reserve:** Grades 12 and below (rated under 1200) (Game/40) USCF RATED (4 rounds)
- Elementary:** Grades 5 and below (Game/40) USCF RATED (4 rounds)
- Primary:** Grades 3 and below (Game/30) USCF RATED (4 rounds)
- 2-5 Novice:** Grades 2-5 (unrated or under 300, who have not finished in top 5 twice in this section) (4 rounds)
- Note:** *On Feb 27 and Mar 6, the 2-5 Novice section will be split into two sections by grades (2-3, 4-5).*
- K-1:** Kindergarten and 1st Grade only (unrated; rated players may participate) (4 rounds)
